



		<p>JMC asked how aggressive and violent behavior and its impact on staff will be captured. JD noted that this was included in the framework that was referred to under the Safety CLUES.</p> <p>Overall in the consultations, five main areas of focus were identified: acuity and dependency measurement, tipping point, escalation inclusion &amp; safety clues and outcomes.</p> <p>Further discussion on the attendance of staff nurses at the consultation sessions was noted, with PNS reporting lower numbers of staff nurses. PRW advised that staff nurses were in attendance, and that every effort to increase attendance by this group was made, including notice of the consultations which was sent out a minimum of 4 weeks in advance. On further discussion, it was agreed that an additional consultation session will be organized for August. MG suggested sending a specific note to Suzanne Dempsey as chair of the Group Directors of Nursing, to encourage as many staff nurses as possible. This was agreed by all.</p>
