1. Specified Purpose: The personal data sought from you is required for the purpose of terminating the arrangement between the scheme applicant and the agricultural agent for the scheme(s) selected on this form.

2. Legal Basis: The legal basis for processing this personal data is Article 6(1) (b), (c) and (e) of Regulation (EU) 2016/79 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 (the General Data Protection Regulation) i.e. processing is necessary for the performance of a contract to which the data subject is party or in order to take steps at the request of the data subject prior to entering into a contract, compliance with a legal obligation to which the controller is subject and for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority vested in the controller.

3.
