

LICENCE UNDER SECTION 3(3) OF THE FORESHORE ACT, 1933


The Minister for the Environment, Heritage and Local Government in exercise of the powers conferred on him by Section 3(3) of the Foreshore Act 1933, as amended, hereby authorises Francis Melvin, Rathlee, Easkey, Co Sligo to carry out hand-harvesting of seaweed on the foreshore between Aughris Head and Kilglass, Co. Sligo.

The Licence is granted on condition that:

1. The Licensee shall indemnify and keep indemnified the State and the Minister for Environment, Heritage and Local Government (hereinafter referred to as the Minister) their officers, agents and employees against all actions, loss, claims, damages, costs, expenses and demands arising in any manner whatsoever in connection with the said works or in the exercise of the permission hereby granted.
2. The Licensee shall pay to the Minister the sum of [REDACTED] on the execution hereof in recognition of the rights and interests of the State in the foreshore concerned.
3. The Licensee shall use that part of the foreshore, the subject matter of this Licence, for the purpose of undertaking hand-harvesting of seaweed on the foreshore between Aughris Head and Kilglass, Co. Sligo and for no other purpose whatsoever.
4. The Licensee shall ensure that the minimum area of access routes to the works site is utilised to reduce the temporary impact from the proposed works.
5. The Minister shall be at liberty at any time to terminate this Licence by giving to the Licensee notice in writing and upon determination of such notice the Licence and permission hereby granted shall be deemed to be revoked and withdrawn without any liability for the payment of compensation by the Minister to the Licensee.
6. The Licensee shall if so required by the Minister after receipt of such notice, or on the termination of this Licence from any other cause, at its own expense remove any or all equipment in connection with the said works to the satisfaction of the Minister and if the Licensee refuses or fails to do so the Minister may cause the said equipment to be removed and shall be entitled to be paid by and to recover from the Licensee as a civil debt due to the State all costs and expenses incurred by him in connection with such removal.
7. In the event of the breach, non-performance or non-observance by the Licensee of any of the conditions herein contained the Minister may forthwith terminate this Licence without prior notice to the Licensee.
8. Any notice to be given by the Minister may be transmitted through the Post Office addressed to the Licensee at its last known address.

And on specific condition that:

9. This Licence is for a 5 year period commencing 28th March 2007 and ending 27th March 2013.
10. Seaweed must only be harvested from within the areas marked in green on the attached map.
11. This Licence does not confer upon the Licensee exclusive entitlement to harvest seaweed in the area defined at Condition 10, and the Minister at all times reserves the right to License other seaweed harvesting operations and any other legitimate activity in the said area if it is in the public interest to do so.
12. The Licensee shall only harvest the species and quantities of seaweed as set out in the Schedule of species and quantity of seaweed to be harvested
13. The use of mechanical methods of harvesting is prohibited.
14. To facilitate regeneration of the seaweed at the areas harvested, the Licensee shall ensure that the bottom 10-15 cms of the plant is not harvested.
15. The Licensee shall comply with all lawful instructions given by the Department of the Environment, Heritage and Local Government in relation to all seaweed harvesting to be carried out within the area covered by this Licence and, in the event that the Licensee disputes any such instruction, no harvesting shall commence or be undertaken without the prior consent of the Minister for Environment, Heritage and Local Government.
16. No structures shall be placed on the foreshore. No materials or harvested seaweed shall be stored on the foreshore, nor shall the foreshore or any beach material be interfered with in anyway.
17. This Licence does not preclude and the Licensee shall not have the right to interfere with the exercise of any other rights or the undertaking of any other activities permitted by Law in the area defined at Condition 10.
