AREAS OF THE HEALTH SERVICES THAT ARE IMPROVING

Hospitalisation rates for diabetes and heart failure



have decreased substantially



30-day mortality for ischaemic stroke decreased 28% over 10 years



In-hospital mortality rates following admission with a heart attack decreased by 100 between 2006 & 2016

Survival rates for patients with breast, cervical and colorectal cancer are improving

Rates of **MRSA** have fallen by **66%** over last 10 years
