Qualifications

1. Character
Each candidate must be of good character.
2. Health
Candidates shall be in a state of health such as would indicate a reasonable prospect of ability to render regular and efficient service.


Education, Experience etc.

Candidates shall, at the closing date for receipt of applications:

- (a) hold a professional qualification in Architecture that is prescribed under the Building Control Act 2007, or a qualification in Architecture, that is equivalent to a qualification so prescribed in Section 14 of the Building Control Act 2007 and
- (b) be eligible for registration as an Architect under the Building Control Act 2007 without requiring further assessment. Any appointment by the employing local authority will be subject to registration under the Act; and
- (c) possess a high standard of technical training and experience.

In exercise of the functions conferred on the Minister for Housing, Local Government and Heritage, by section 160 of the Local Government Act, 2001 (No. 37 of 2001), which said functions have been delegated to me by the said Minister by virtue of section 236(7) of the said Act, I, Mary Hurley, Assistant Secretary, Department of Housing, Local Government and Heritage, hereby declare the foregoing to be the Qualifications for Assistant Architect.
