Qualifications

1. Character

Each candidate must be of good character.


2. Health

Each candidate shall be in a state of health such as would indicate a reasonable prospect of ability to render regular and efficient service.

3. Education, Experience etc.

Each candidate shall, on the latest date for receipt of completed application forms:

- (a) hold a professional qualification in Architecture that is prescribed under the Building Control Act 2007, or a qualification in Architecture that is equivalent to a qualification so prescribed in Section 14 of the Building Control Act 2007, and
- (b) be eligible for registration as an Architect under the Building Control Act 2007 without requiring further assessment. Any appointment by the employing local authority will be subject to registration under the Act;
- (c) have at least seven years satisfactory relevant experience of architectural work including a period of not less than five years satisfactory experience in a responsible capacity as team leader of multi-disciplinary design teams and the administration of construction contracts as Employer's Agent or equivalent role;
- (d) have knowledge of the principles of Urban Design and planning policy and practice;
- (e) have satisfactory experience at strategic management level;
- (f) have satisfactory knowledge of public service organisation or the ability to acquire such knowledge.
