Qualifications

1. Character

Each candidate must be of good character.

2. Health

Candidates shall be in a state of health such as would indicate a reasonable prospect of ability to render regular and efficient service.


3. Education, Experience etc.

Candidates shall, on the latest date for receipt of applications:

- (a) hold a professional qualification in Architecture that is prescribed under the Building Control Act 2007, or a qualification in Architecture, that is equivalent to a qualification so prescribed in Section 14 of the Building Control Act 2007, and
- (b) be eligible for registration as an Architect under the Building Control Act 2007 without requiring further assessment. Any appointment by the employing local authority will be subject to registration under the Act;
- (c) have at least five years satisfactory relevant experience of architectural work;
- (d) have experience in the design of buildings, the preparation of sketch plans, working drawings, details and specification;
- (e) have knowledge of the principles of Urban Design and planning policy and practice;
- (f) have a satisfactory knowledge of public service organisation or the ability to acquire such knowledge.

In exercise of the functions conferred on the Minister for Housing, Local Government and Heritage by section 160 of the Local Government Act, 2001 (No. 37 of 2001), which said functions have been delegated to me by the said Minister by virtue of section 236(7) of the said Act, I, Fiona Quinn, Assistant Secretary, Department of Housing, Local Government and Heritage hereby declare the foregoing to be the Qualifications for Senior Executive Architect.
