Introduction

This Helpsheet should be read in conjunction with the Terms and Conditions of the 2021 Areas of Natural Constraints (ANC) Scheme and before submitting your Application Form online.

Please familiarise yourself fully with the Terms and Conditions of the Scheme before completing your Application Form as the onus will be on you, the applicant(s), to comply fully with them in order to qualify for payment. Terms and Conditions 2021

Applications for the scheme (previously the Disadvantaged Areas Scheme) must be made using the Basic Payment Online Application System by ticking the appropriate box on the Online Application at www.agfood.ie

Please note you must tick the box, located under the heading of "Other Schemes and Activities" to confirm that you wish to apply for payment under the Areas of Natural Constraints Scheme. In the event you have no land changes to declare in your 2021 BPS application, it will still be necessary to tick the box to apply for the Areas of Natural Constraints (ANC) scheme in 2021.

Failure to tick this box will mean that you will not be eligible for payment under the ANC scheme in 2021.

All applications must be submitted by midnight on 17 May 2021.

To qualify for the ANC/ASC Scheme you must:

Hold a valid herd number or have applied to the Local District Veterinary Office for a herd number, on or before 17th May 2021,

Farm eligible disadvantaged lands in your own right.

Maintain a minimum stocking density of 0.15 livestock units per eligible forage hectare for 7 consecutive months within the 2021 calendar year.

Maintain an annual average stocking density of 0.15 livestock units per eligible forage hectare for the 2021 calendar year.

With regards to specific stocking requirements, please note the following:

Cattle, sheep, horses, donkeys, goats and deer are animals which are eligible to satisfy stocking requirements. Donkeys can only account for 50% of stocking density requirements. Applicants with donkeys only will need additional animals from one of the other eligible animal types to satisfy the remaining 50% requirement.

Applicants with sheep and/or goats must have submitted a valid Sheep/Goat Census return within the specified timelines.

In cases where it is necessary to submit your flock register for sheep and goats, the Original Flock/ Goat Register must be submitted – certified copies will not be accepted.

For animals with no national movement database i.e. horses/donkeys, proof of ownership of such animals will be required for each year. In the case of equines, the Original Passport must be submitted – certified copies will not be accepted.

In the case of equines, specific requirements concerning breeding enterprise criteria and equine age apply. Please consult Section 7 of the ANC terms and conditions document entitled Stocking Requirements for further information

In the case of new entrants, applicants are required to meet the minimum required stocking density within **10 working days** of receiving their herd number.

Where a holding has been restricted due to the presence of an animal disease (e.g. TB) applicants are required to meet the minimum required stocking density within 10 working days of derestriction.
