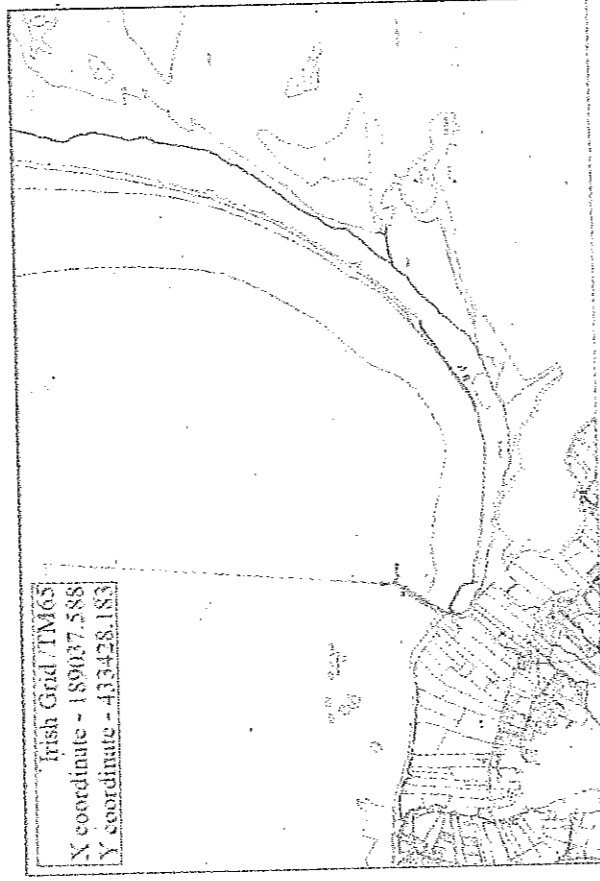


Comhairle Contae Dhún na nGall Donegal County Council

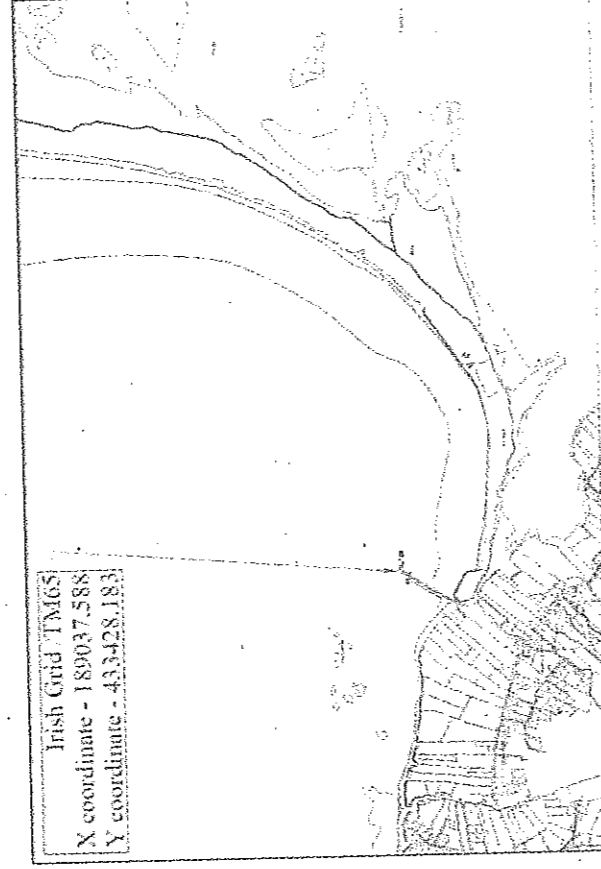

APPLICATION FOR A FORESHORE LEASE

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 19 of the Foreshore Act, 1933 that Donegal Co. Council has applied to the Minister of Housing, Local Government and Heritage for a Foreshore licence under Section 3 of the said Act for dredging at Magheraroarty pier and disposal of dredged material by spreading it as beach nourishment on Doosey Strand.



A copy of the application, and the relevant documents, maps, plans, and drawings, are available for inspection, between 12th March 2021 and 12th April 2021, free of charge at:

In light of National Level 5 Covid-19 restrictions Regulations published under the Health Act 1947 (Statutory Instrument No. 448 of 2020) have identified planning-related activity within the schedule of what is considered to be 'essential services' in order to ensure the continued and safe operation of all aspects of the statutory planning system. The Regulations permit a person to attend the offices of a planning authority or An Bord Pleanála to engage in a statutory planning process. There is no specified restriction on the distance that persons engaging in a statutory planning process, may travel.

The closing date for submissions is close of business (17:30) on 12th April 2021.

All objections and representations received will be forwarded to the applicant for comment prior to any decision being made in the matter. Material upon which the Minister shall determine this application may be published on the Department's website.
