


# Ireland National Sheep and Goat Census December 2020

#### **National Sheep and Goat Census**

#### December 2020

In accordance with the requirements of Council Regulation (EC) No. 21/2004, the Department of Agriculture, Food and the Marine (DAFM) has carried out an annual census of sheep and goats since 2005. This census report records the number of sheep and goats kept in Ireland on 31<sup>st</sup> December 2020 and is based on data submitted to the Department by 15<sup>th</sup> April 2021.

Data from the 2020 census returns record that a total of 3.88 million sheep were kept in 35,592 registered herds in the country at the end December 2020. This represents an increase of approximately 69,000 (2%) on the total numbers recorded for December 2019.

2020 goat census returns record a total of 9,403 goats kept in 732 registered herds at end December 2020. This represents an increase of approximately 629 (7%) on the figures recorded in respect of December 2019.



Sheep

2020 sheep census forms were issued to 46,332 sheep keepers registered with DAFM. This included

approximately 1,500 new sheep herds approved by the Department in 2020, along with a further 500

herd numbers reactivated for sheep.

A response rate of 90% was achieved with returns received from

- 35,592 herds where sheep were kept; and

6,233 herds where no sheep were kept at the time of the census.

Just under 700 respondents without sheep indicated that they did not intend to re-enter sheep farming

in the near future.

Approximately 39% of 2020 returns (14,000) were submitted online via the Department's agfood.ie

service. Over 12,000 were submitted directly by keepers, with some 2,000 submitted by agents on behalf

of keepers. In total, 2020 online responses increased by around 3,000 on 2019 returns. The online system

provides immediate confirmation to keepers when the information submitted has been received by the

Department. Furthermore, the online service provides keepers with a facility to view all census data

provided in previous years.

The census returns indicate that, in the State on 31st December 2020

- 3.88 million sheep (3,877,222) were kept across 35,592 registered holdings, representing an

increase of 1.8% (67,854) on the December 2019 sheep population figure of 3.81 million.

- there were 2.64 million breeding ewes over 12 months of age, which is an increase of

approximately 72,000 (2.8%) on the previous year's breeding ewe population of 2.57 million.

- a total of 87,063 breeding rams were recorded.

- 1.14 million other sheep were recorded (including lambs, wethers, cull ewes etc.).

- the number of registered holdings keeping sheep increased by 654 (2%) on the December 2019

figure of 34,938.

overall, the greatest number of sheep was kept in Donegal with a sheep population of 535,949.

- the greatest number of mountain sheep (223,575) was kept in Mayo.

- Donegal contained the greatest number of mountain cross sheep with 109,977.


- the greatest number of lowland (119,466) and lowland cross (160,410) breeds were in Galway.

- the average number of sheep per flock was 109, which was the same in 2019; and

- a total of 66% of flocks (23,407) kept 100 sheep or less.












## **Total Number of Sheep Flocks by County**

December 2020






#### Breakdown of National Flock by Breeding Ewes, Breeding Rams and Other Sheep

Data on breakdown of the national flock according to breeding ewes, breeding rams and other sheep collected as part of the annual census since 2009 show that, following a general increase in numbers between 2009 and 2016, the number in each category has levelled out and is fluctuating at around 2016/2017 levels.




#### Distribution of all Mountain / Mountain Cross Breeds by County

The distribution of all mountain breeds, i.e. mountain and mountain cross, by county is set out below. As in 2016 to 2019 the data shows that Donegal, and Mayo each account for approximately 16% of all mountain sheep, and when combined with Kerry's 15%, the total for the three counties accounts for almost half (48%) of all mountain sheep in the country.



#### Distribution of all Lowland / Lowland Cross Breeds by County

The distribution of all lowland breeds, i.e. lowland and lowland cross, by county is set out below. As in 2016 to 2019 the data show that Galway has the highest number of lowland sheep and accounts for 14% of all lowland sheep followed by Donegal with 11% and Roscommon with 8%.



#### **Number of Flocks within certain Flock Sizes**



#### Goats


Goat census returns were received from 1,032 registered goat keepers, representing a response rate 80%.

A total of 9,403 goats were recorded - an increase of approximately 7% (629 goats) on the December 2019 figure.

732 respondent keepers declared that they had goats in December 2020. This is an increase of 43 on the 689 herds recorded keeping goats in 2019.

With 105 herds, Cork had the greatest number of goat herds.

The greatest number of goats was kept in Tipperary where 923 goats were recorded, closely followed by Cavan with 903.

#### Number of Goats and Number of Goat Herds by Size of Herd

As in previous years the vast majority of domestic goats are kept in very small numbers on a non-commercial basis, with only 28 herds in the country containing over 50 goats. The total number of goats held in those 28 herds accounts for 57% of the total goat population which is unchanged from 2019.
