

## OUTDOOR MUSIC FESTIVAL TAKING PLACE ON SATURDAY 3<sup>RD</sup> OF JULY 2021 IN THE GROUNDS OF THE ROYAL HOSPITAL KILMAINHAM

Dear Resident,

We are writing to you to inform you of the arrangements for an upcoming outdoor pilot music festival taking place on the grounds of the Irish Museum of Modern Art, Royal Hospital Kilmainham, Dublin. The Government of Ireland have recently confirmed this open-air, socially-distanced pilot music festival with a capacity of 3,500 to take place on Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2021.

The event will feature popular Irish Artists, including **Gavin James, Lyra, Denise Chaila, Wild Youth, Sharon Shannon & Wyvern Lingo**. The show will be hosted by **The 2 Johnnies**.

The Event is a Government of Ireland pilot event, produced by MCD Productions and hosted by IMMA in the Royal Hospital Kilmainham, in association with the Department of Tourism, Culture, Arts, Gaeltacht, Sport and Media, the OPW and Dublin City Council. The event management have been liaising with all relevant statutory agencies including An Garda Síochana, to ensure that a robust event management plan is in place and that any disruption to the local neighbourhood and surrounding areas is kept to a minimum, insofar as is possible while holding an event of this nature.

The age Policy will be strictly over 18s. Event Security and Gardaí will be on duty both in and outside the event.

### **Garda Traffic Management Plan 3<sup>rd</sup> July**

- Kilmainham Lane will be confined to one way traffic outbound only from 13.00hrs.
- There will be barriers / cones and Gardaí present at the junction with Kilmainham Lane / SCR to enforce this one way traffic.
- It is envisaged that all other Roads in the area will remain open during this event.
- Cars displaying a disability badge will be permitted to use the East Gate to access the Event.

- An independent Acoustics Consultant will monitor noise levels throughout the event in accordance with the 'Code of Practice on Environmental Noise at Concerts.
- There will be a robust litter management plan in operation both inside and outside the venue. The areas surrounding and outside the venue will be returned to an as found condition by the morning of the 4<sup>th</sup> of July 2021.
