What Templates would you regard as being helpful to include in a revised PPN User Guide (Constitution, Grievance Procedure, Representatives Charter, Expense Policy, Memorandum of Understanding, etc.)

Firstly a set of 'rules'.

A 'self check score', i.e. for the ppn itself to rate itself on how it is performing structurally .

A check on tasks to be achieved by secretariet, monthly / annually etc.

A complaints procedure, i.e. plenary not held twice a year, what happens then?

Any other Recommendations in relation to the review of the User Guide?

Inform the wider PPN of key issues and policy positions.
