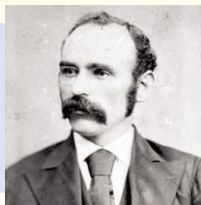

In accordance with Section 21A of the Foreshore Act, 1933 (as amended), the Minister of State, Department of Housing, Local Government and Heritage with special responsibility for Planning and Local Government ("the Minister") hereby gives notice that he has determined an application dated 01/08/2019 for a licence under Section 3(1) of the Foreshore Act, 1933 (as amended) made by Greenlink Interconnector Limited ("the Applicant") in respect of carrying out associated works in connection with the laying of a new subsea electricity interconnector cable between Irish and UK electricity grid extending from the landfall at Baginbun Beach, Ramstown, County Wexford, and at the Campile Estuary, Dunbrody, County Wexford. An application for leave to apply for judicial review shall be made within three months from the date when grounds for the application first arose under Section 21(1) of the Order 84 of the Rules of the Superior Courts as amended by S.I No 691 of 2011. The time-limit for such a review commences from the Date of Publication of the full Notice of Determination.
