Schedule of Updates for Eurostat Statistics 2021



This calendar records the planned submission dates for the Department of Justice contribution to Eurostat immigration statistics in 2021.

Statistics are categorised by publication frequency: monthly, quarterly or annual.

The returns are published by Eurostat via their website, https://ec.europa.eu/eurostat/web/asylum-and-managed-migration/data/database. Eurostat is the statistical body of the European Commission. Further information on Eurostat can be sourced from their website, https://ec.europa.eu/eurostat.

For each statistical release, the reference period and submission dates to Eurostat are shown.

In all cases, the submission date is indicated as not later than ("nlt") a given day in the month.

This Schedule will be updated monthly and the update published on the Department of Justice website by the 15th of each month.

In each following month, the timeliness of releases in the previous month will be shown by colour code.



The Schedule of Updates for 2022 will issue in January 2022.
