BYE-LAW.

The use of Draught Nets, or any other Nets used as a Draught Net, having a Foot Rope and Leads or Weights affixed thereto, is hereby prohibited during the Close Season for Salmon, in the

ESTUARY OF CASTLEMAINE,

INSIDE THE

BAR OF INCH,

IN THE COUNTY OF KERRY,

or in any of the Rivers flowing into the said Estuary, within the said Bar of Inch.

Any Person offending against this Bye-Law shall forfeit and pay a Sum of

TWO POUNDS,

and all such Nets so used contrary to this Bye-Law will be forfeited.
