# FISHERIES-IRELAND.

32 & 33 Vic., chap. 92, and the Acts incorporated therewith.

## NO. 10<sup>2</sup>, OR BANGOR DISTRICT. CLOSE SEASON.

WE, the Inspectors of Irish Fisheries, acting in execution of the Fisheries (Ireland) Act, 1869, and the Acts incorporated therewith, in pursuance of the powers and authorities in us vested in that behalf by said Acts, do hereby decide that the respective periods authorized and directed as the Close Time for Salmon and Trout in the Newport, Burrishoole, Owengarve, and Glenamoy Rivers, in the District No. 10<sup>2</sup>, heretofore defined and known as "The Bangor District," situated in the County of Mayo, shall cease.

1. And We do hereby further decide that the Close Time, during which no Fish of the Salmon or Trout kind shall be killed, destroyed, or taken by any Person or by any means whatsoever (save by Single Rods and Lines as hereinafter provided) in or from the Newport River, and the Estuary thereof, within the said Bangor District, shall be between the 1st day of September in each year and the 19th day of March in the year following, both the said days inclusive.

2. And We do hereby further decide that the Close Time, during which no Fish of the Salmon or Trout kind shall be killed, destroyed, or taken by any Person by Single Rods and Lines in the said Newport River, and its Tributaries, shall be between the 1st day of October in each year and the 30th day of April in the year following, both said days inclusive.

3. And We do hereby further decide that the Close Time, during which no Fish of the Salmon or Trout kind shall be killed, destroyed, or taken by any Person or by any means whatsoever (save by Single Rods and Lines as hereinafter provided) in or from the Burrishoole and Owengarve Rivers, and the Estuaries thereof, within the said Bangor District, shall be between the 1st day of September in each year and the 15th day of February in the year following, both said days inclusive.

4. And We do hereby further decide that the Close Time, during which no Fish of the Salmon or Trout kind shall be killed, destroyed, or taken by any Person or by any means whatsoever (save by Single Rods and Lines as hereinafter provided) in or from the Glenamoy River, and the Estuary thereof, within the said Bangor District, shall be between the 16th day of September in each year and the 30th day of April in the year following, both said days inclusive.

5. And We do hereby further decide that the Close Time, during which no Fish of the Salmon or Trout kind shall be killed, destroyed, or taken by any Person by Single Rods and Lines in or from the Owengarve and Glenamoy Rivers, and their Tributaries, within the said Bangor District, shall be between the 1st day of November in each year and the 30th day of April in the year following, both said days inclusive.

6. And We do hereby further decide that the Close Time, during which no Fish of the Salmon or Trout kind shall be killed, destroyed, or taken by any Person by Single Rods and Lines in or from the Burrishoole River, and its Tributaries, within the said Bangor District, shall be between the 1st day of November in each year and the 31st day of January in the year following, both said days inclusive.
