CLOSE SEASON.

WE, the Inspectors of Irish Fisheries, acting in execution of the Fisheries (Ireland) Act, 1869, and the Acts incorporated therewith, in pursuance of the powers and authorities in us vested in that behalf by said Acts, do hereby decide that the respective periods authorized and directed as the Close Time during which it should not be lawful to capture Salmon and Trout by means of Single Rods and Lines only, in the Bellaveeny and Owenduff Rivers and their Tributaries, situated in the District No. 10², heretofore defined and known as "The Bangor District," situated in the County of Mayo, shall cease.

And We do hereby further decide that the Close Time, during which no Fish of the Salmon or Trout kind shall be killed, destroyed, or taken by any Person by Single Rods and Lines in the said Bellaveeny and Owenduff Rivers and their Tributaries, within the said Bangor District, shall be between the 1st day of November in each Year and the 31st day of January in the Year following, both the said days inclusive.
