SPIDDLE RIVER.

CLOSE SEASON, SINGLE RODS AND LINES.

WE, the Inspectors of Irish Fisheries, acting in execution of the Fisheries (Ireland) Act, 1869, and the Acts incorporated therewith, in pursuance of the powers and authorities in us vested in that behalf by said Acts, do hereby decide that the period authorized and directed as the Close Time during which it shall not be lawful to capture Salmon or Trout, by means of Single Rods and Lines only, in the Spiddle River and its Tributaries, in the County of Galway, shall cease.

1. And We do hereby further decide that the Close Time, during which it shall not be lawful to kill, destroy, or take Salmon or Trout in the Spiddle River and its Tributaries, in the County of Galway with Single Rods and Lines only, shall be between the 1st November in each Year and 31st January in the Year following, both said days inclusive.
