GWEEBARRA RIVER.

CLOSE SEASON.

WE, the Inspectors of Irish Fisheries, acting in execution of the Fisheries (Ireland) Act, 1869, and the Acts incorporated therewith, in pursuance of the powers and authorities in us vested in that behalf by said Acts, do hereby decide that the period authorized and directed as the Close Time for Salmon and Trout in the Gweebarra River, in the District No. 14, heretofore defined and known as "The Letterkenny District," situated in the County of Donegal, shall cease.

1. And we do hereby further decide that the Close Time during which it shall not be lawful to kill, destroy, or take Salmon or Trout in the said Gweebarra River, in said Letterkenny District, in the County of Donegal, with Nets and all other Engines (save single Rods and Lines only) shall be between the 1st October in each Year and 31st March in the Year following, both said days inclusive.

2. And We do hereby further decide that the Close Time during which it shall not be lawful to kill, destroy, or take Salmon or Trout in the said Gweebarra River, in the said Letterkenny District, by Single Rods and Lines shall be between the 1st day of November in each Year and the 1st day of February in the Year following,

both said days inclusive
