BY-LAW.

By the Department of Agriculture and Technical
Instruction for Ireland.

The Department of Agriculture and Technical Instruction for Ireland, by virtue and in exercise of the powers in them vested under the Agriculture and Technical Instruction (Ireland) Act, 1899, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do hereby permit between the 1st day of November in each year, and the 31st day of January in the following year, both said days inclusive, the taking of Oysters by the hand from the Public or Natural Oyster Beds of Oranmore Bay, County Galway, within an imaginary straight line from Rinville Point in the townland of Rinville West to Comyns Point (West) in the townland of Roscam.
