BY-LAW.

TRAMMEL NETS—DUNDRUM BAY.

By the Department of Agriculture and Technical Instruction for Ireland.

The Department of Agriculture and Technical Instruction for Ireland, by virtue and in exercise of the powers in them vested under the Agriculture and Technical Instruction (Ireland) Act, 1899, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, and being of opinion that Trammel Nets may be used in the day-time without injury to the fisheries in that part of Dundrum Bay hereinafter described, do hereby make and ordain the following By-Law:—

It is hereby PERMITTED to use Trammel Nets for the capture of Sea Fish between sunrise and sunset in that part of Dundrum Bay which is inside or landward of an imaginary straight line from St. John's Point to Mullartown Point, both in the County of Down.

NOTICE.

Copies of the above *proposed* By-Law have been lodged with the Clerk of the Peace for the County of Down; and with Clerks of Petty Sessions for the Districts of Kilkeel, Newcastle, Castlewellan, Seaforde, Downpatrick and Ardglass (County Down).

And all persons concerned are hereby required to take NOTICE that the said By-Law will, at the expiration of ONE CALENDAR MONTH from the posting hereof, be lodged for approval and sanction with the LORD LIEUTENANT in COUNCIL, to whom any person who considers himself aggrieved thereby is entitled to appeal.

Pending such approval and sanction this proposed By-Law has no legal authority or validity; and any person infringing the existing Law in the meantime will be liable to prosecution.
