BY-LAW.

No. 11, or Ballina District.

By the Department of Agriculture and Technical Instruction for Ireland.

The Department of Agriculture and Technical Instruction for Ireland, by virtue and in exercise of the powers in them vested under the Agriculture and Technical Instruction (Ireland) Act, 1899, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do make and ordain the following By-Law :—

It is hereby prohibited to use any Drift Net for the capture of Salmon or Trout within one mile of the Mouths, as at present defined, or may hereafter be redefined, of the Easky, Cloonaghmore, and Ballingen Rivers, in the No. 11, or Ballina District.

Each and every person offending against the above By-Law shall, for each offence, forfeit and pay a sum not exceeding FIVE POUNDS ; and all Nets used contrary thereto shall be forfeited.
