

## BY-LAW.

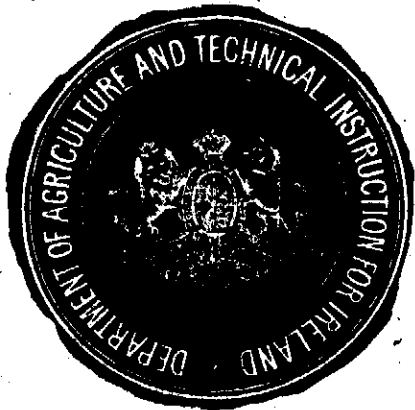
# NO. 17<sup>2</sup>, OR DUNDALK DISTRICT.

By the Department of Agriculture and Technical Instruction for Ireland.

The Department of Agriculture and Technical Instruction for Ireland, by virtue and in exercise of the powers in them vested under the Agriculture and Technical Instruction (Ireland) Act, 1899, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do hereby make this By-Law, by which it is prohibited and it is hereby prohibited to use any net for the purpose of taking fish or with the intent to take fish in that part of the River Ballymascanlan indicated by plain hatching thus  within the lines A and B on the Map hereon—save landing nets for use solely as auxiliary to fishing legally with rod and line.

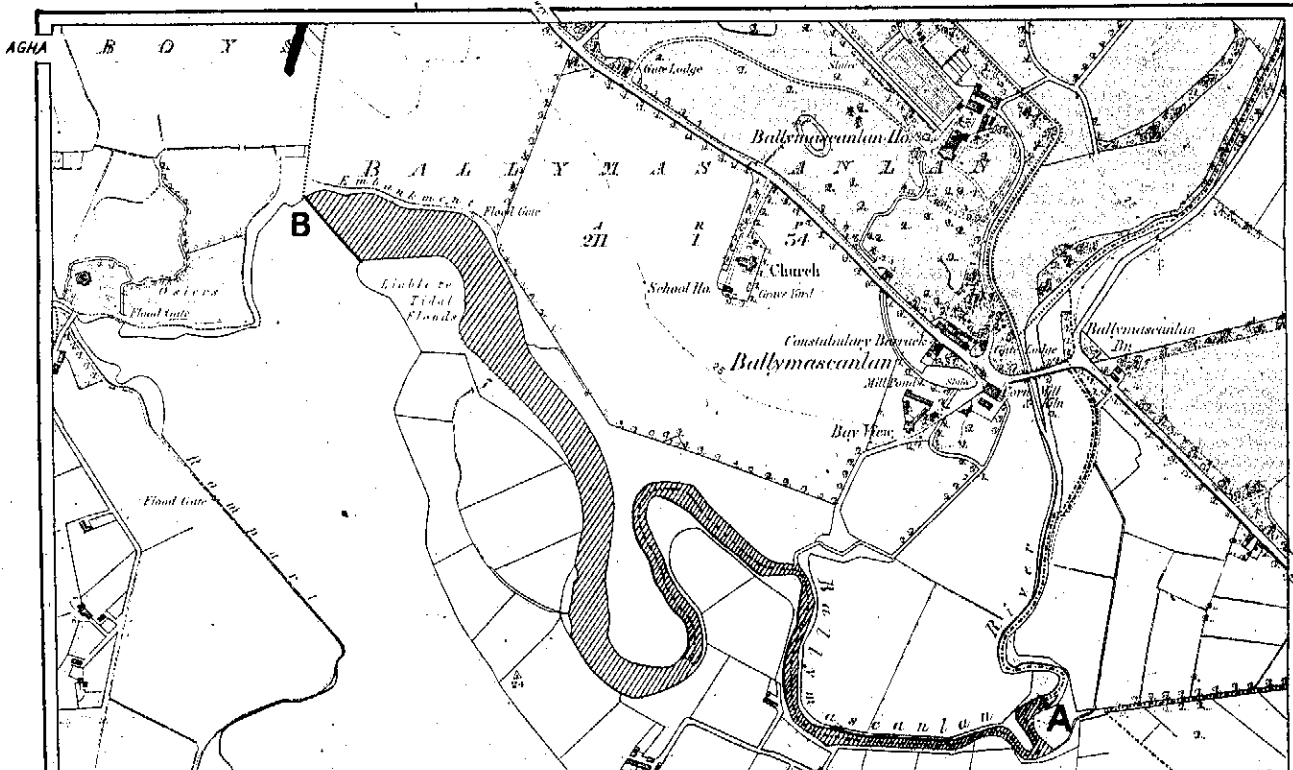
Each and every person offending against this By-Law shall, for each offence, forfeit and pay a sum not exceeding FIVE POUNDS; and every net used contrary thereto shall be forfeited.



# BY-LAW.

## NO. 17<sup>2</sup>, OR DUNDALK DISTRICT.

By the Department of Agriculture and Technical Instruction for Ireland.

The Department of Agriculture and Technical Instruction for Ireland, by virtue and in exercise of the powers in them vested under the Agriculture and Technical Instruction (Ireland) Act, 1899, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do hereby make this By-Law, by which it is prohibited and it is hereby prohibited to use any net for the purpose of taking fish or with the intent to take fish in that part of the River Ballymascanlan indicated by plain hatching thus  within the lines A and B on the Map hereon—save landing nets for use solely as auxiliary to fishing legally with rod and line.

Each and every person offending against this By-Law shall, for each offence, forfeit and pay a sum not exceeding FIVE POUNDS; and every net used contrary thereto shall be forfeited.
