LOUGHS ENNELL AND DERRAVARAGH.

By the Department of Agriculture and Technical Instruction for Ireland.

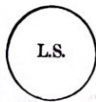
The Department of Agriculture and Technical Instruction for Ireland, by virtue and in exercise of the powers in them vested under the Agriculture and Technical Instruction (Ireland) Act, 1899, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do make and ordain the following By-Laws:—

1. It is hereby prohibited to use between sunset and sunrise any net for the purpose of taking fish or with the intent to take fish in Loughs Ennell and Derravaragh (in the County of Westmeath), save landing nets for use solely as auxiliary to fishing legally with rod and line.

2. It is hereby prohibited to use between sunrise and sunset in the said Loughs Ennell and Derravaragh any net for the purpose of taking fish or with the intent to take fish, save drum nets and sheet nets for the capture of perch and pike, and save landing nets for use solely as auxiliary to fishing legally with rod and line.

Each and every person offending against either of the above By-Laws shall, for each offence, forfeit and pay a sum not exceeding FIVE POUNDS; and every net used contrary thereto shall be forfeited.
