BY-LAWS.

No. 13, OR BALLYSHANNON DISTRICT.

LOWER LOUGH ERNE.

By the Department of Agriculture and Technical Instruction for Ireland.

The Department of Agriculture and Technical Instruction for Ireland, by virtue and in exercise of the powers in them vested under the Agriculture and Technical Instruction (Ireland) Act, 1899, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf,

1. Do hereby repeal the By-Law dated 30th June, 1874, by which it is permitted for any person having the right of using Nets in Lower Lough Erne, to use same for the taking of Fish with Meshes of One Inch from Knot to Knot (to be measured along the side of the square, or Four Inches to be measured all round each such Mesh, such measurements being taken in the clear when the Net is wet), in said Lough Erne, between Enniskillen and Belleek, in the County of Fermanagh, between the 1st day of May and the 1st day of the Close Season in each year.

2. And do hereby prohibit the use of any cross line in Lower Lough Erne at all times save between the 1st day of March and the 15th day of May in each year.

Each and every person offending against the foregoing By-Law No. 2 shall, for each offence, forfeit and pay a sum not exceeding FIVE POUNDS ; and every cross line used contrary thereto shall be forfeited.
