BY-LAWS.

No. 8, OR LIMERICK DISTRICT. LOUGH GARA (UPPER AND LOWER).

By the Department of Agriculture and Technical Instruction for Ireland.

The Department of Agriculture and Technical Instruction for Ireland, by virtue and in exercise of the powers in them vested under the Agriculture and Technical Instruction (Ireland) Act, 1899, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, and being of opinion that the following restrictions are necessary and expedient for the more effectual government, management, protection and improvement of the fisheries of Lough Gara (Upper and Lower) situated in the Counties of Roscommon and Sligo, do make and ordain the following By-Laws:—

1. It is hereby prohibited to use any Draft Net or Seine Net for the capture of Fish in the said Lough Gara (Upper and Lower).
2. It is hereby prohibited to have on board any boat in the said Lough Gara (Upper and Lower) any Draft Net or Seine Net for the capture of Fish.

Each and every person offending against either of the above By-Laws shall, for each offence, forfeit and pay a sum not exceeding FIVE POUNDS.
