No. 2, OR WEXFORD DISTRICT.

BY-LAW

By the Department of Agriculture and Technical Instruction for Ireland.

The Department of Agriculture and Technical Instruction for Ireland, by virtue and in exercise of the powers in them vested under the Agriculture and Technical Instruction (Ireland) Act, 1899, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, and being of opinion that the following restriction is necessary and expedient for the more effectual government, management, protection, and improvement of the fisheries of the District defined and known as the No. 2, or Wexford District, DO MAKE AND ORDAIN THE FOLLOWING BY-LAW:—

It is hereby prohibited to use any Drift Net for the capture of Salmon or Trout off the coast of the Wexford District between a line drawn south (true) from Kiln Bay (east of Bannow Bay) and a line drawn east (true) from Cahore Point, PROVIDED ALWAYS that nothing in this By-Law shall affect the provisions of the By-Laws relating to the Fisheries of the Wexford District, dated 29th March, 1900, and 2nd December, 1902.

Each and every person offending against the above By-Law shall, for each offence, forfeit and pay a sum of FIVE POUNDS, and all Nets used contrary thereto shall be forfeited.
