CASTLEMAINE HARBOUR.

BY-LAW

By the Department of Agriculture and Technical Instruction for Ireland.

The Department of Agriculture and Technical Instruction for Ireland, by virtue and in exercise of the powers in them vested under the Agriculture and Technical Instruction (Ireland) Act, 1899, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do hereby fix the period from 1st day of June, 1918, to 31st day of October, 1919, both said days inclusive, during which it shall not be lawful to take or attempt to take Mussels, below low-water mark of Spring tides, in that part of Castlemaine Harbour which lies between imaginary lines drawn

(a) between Lack Bridge in the townland of Lack and Cromane Point in the townland of Cromane Lower and

(b) between Aughils Bridge in the townland of Aughils and Crow's Point in the townland of Cromane Lower.

Each and every person offending against the above By-Law shall, for each offence, forfeit and pay a sum not exceeding FIVE POUNDS.
