## BY-LAWS

By the Department of Agriculture and Technical Instruction for Ireland.

The Department of Agriculture and Technical Instruction for Ireland, by virtue and in exercise of the powers in them vested under the Agriculture and Technical Instruction (Ireland) Act, 1899, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf.

- 1. Do hereby decide that the period authorised and directed as the Close Time during which it shall not be lawful to kill, destroy or take Salmon and Trout by means of Single Rod and Line in or from the Rivers and their Lakes and Tributaries flowing into the Sea between the most westerly point of Kells Bay and Bolus Head, in the District No. 7<sup>2</sup> heretofore defined and known as "The Waterville District," shall cease.
- 2. And do hereby further decide that the Close Time during which it shall not be lawful to kill, destroy or take Salmon and Trout by means of Single Rod and Line in or from the Rivers and their Lakes and Tributaries flowing into the Sea between the most westerly point of Kells Bay and Bolus Head, in the said No. 7², or Waterville District, shall be from the 15th day of October to the 31st day of March in the year following, both said days inclusive.
