# FISHERIES—IRELAND.

32 & 33 Vic., c. 92, and the Acts incorporated therewith.

No. 14, or LETTERKENNY DISTRICT.

LENNAN OR RATHMELTON RIVER.

CLOSE SEASON.

WE, the Inspectors of Irish Fisheries, acting in execution of the Fisheries (Ireland) Act, 1869, and the Acts incorporated therewith, in pursuance of the powers and authorities in us vested in that behalf by said Acts, do hereby decide that the period authorized and directed as the Close Time for Salmon and Trout in the Lennan or Rathmelton River, in the District No. 14, heretofore defined and known as "The Letterkenny District," situated in the County of Donegal, shall cease.

1. And We do hereby further decide that the Close Time, during which it shall not be lawful to kill, destroy, or take Salmon or Trout in the said Lennan or Rathmelton River, in said Letterkenny District, in the County of Donegal, with Nets and all other Engines (save single Rods and Lines only), shall be between the 16th July and 31st December in each Year, both said days inclusive.
