De bhuard agus i bhfeidhmíú na geomhacht atá dilsithe ionam le hAlt 28 den Acht Iascaigh, 1925, agus leis an Ordú Iascaigh (Seirbhísí Publí d'Athroinnt), 1934, agus de bhuard agus i bhfeidhmíú gach comhachta eile le ne-a gneáirtear so ar mo chumas deimín-se, Séamas Ó Riain, Aire Talmhaiochta AN FO-DHLI SEO LEANAS DO CHEAPADH AGUS D'ORDU :—

(1) Ní bheidh sé cleathach i rith na tréimhse ón ladh lá de Dheire Fómhair, 1935, go dtí an 30adh lá de Mheán Fomhair, 1938, agus an dá lá san d'áireamh, dreidearachta do dhéanamh ar oisri ná ar shiobhach oisri ná breith ortha ná iad do thógaínt ná do mhilleadh sa chuid sin de Bhágh Thráighlí atá lastoí de líne dhlirigh d'arráiceofaí ón bpoinnte is sia ar an dtaoibh Thoir-Thusaídh d'Oileán Doire Mhór i mBaile Fearainn Dhoire Mhór Thiar, Soir o Thuaidh go Seaview House i mBaile Fearainn *Ballymakegoge*, dhá áit atá i gContae Chiárraige.

(2) Gach éinne dhéanfaidh cionta i gcoinne na Fo-dhlí seo geallbhruidfe sé agus iocfaidh in aghaidh gach cionta suim ná raghaidh thar Cúig Piáint agus geallbhruidfear aon oisri no siolrach oisri tóigfar contrárdha don Fho-dhlí sin.

(3) Bainneann an tAcht Léiriúcháin, 1923 (Uimh. 46 de 1923), le léiriú na Fo-dhlí seo fé mar a bhaineann sé le léiriú Acharta den Oireachtas.

(4) Féadfar chun gach críche Fo-dhlí Oisri Bhágh Thráighlí Uimh. 424, 1935, do ghairm den Fho-dhlí seo.

BY-LAW No. 424

OYSTER FISHERIES
TRALEE BAY

I, SÉAMAS Ó RIAIN, Minister for Agriculture, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in me by Section 28 of the Fisheries Act, 1925, the Fisheries (Re-distribution of Public Services) Order, 1934, and of every other power enabling me in this behalf, DO MAKE AND ORDAIN THE FOLLOWING BY-LAW :—

(1) It shall not be lawful during the period from the 1st day of October, 1935, to the 30th day of September, 1938, both said days inclusive, to dredge for, take, catch or destroy any Oyster or Oyster Brood in that part of Tralee Bay which is situated to the Eastward of a straight line drawn from the North-Eastern extremity of Derrymore Island in the Townland of Derrymore West, in a north-easterly direction, to Seaview House in the Townland of Ballymakegoge, both in the County of Kerry.

(2) Each and every person offending against this By-law shall forfeit and pay for each offence a sum not exceeding Five Pounds, and any Oysters or Oyster Brood taken in contravention thereof shall be forfeited.

(3) The Interpretation Act, 1923 (No. 46 of 1923), applies as to the interpretation of this By-law in like manner as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of the Oireachtas.

(4) This By-law may be cited for all purposes as the Tralee Bay Oyster By-law No. 424, 1935.
