2. (1) Na toirmise atá i bhFodhlí Bhéal Átha Seanaigh, Uimh. 511, 1963, ní bheidh feidhm acu i rith na tréimhse dar tosach an 2ú lá de Lúnasa, 1963, agus dar críochnadh an 19ú lá de Lúnasa, 1963, i leith lóna tarrainge nach sia ná cuig slat is ochtó a thí síd nó a shealbhú, in aon áit ar na huisce taoide nó in aice leis na huisce taoide lena mbainín eann an mhír seo chun breith, nó le hintinn breith, ar bhradáin nó ar bhric.

(2) Baineann an mhír seo le—

- (a) uisci taoide Abhann na hÉirne seachas an chuid diobh atá suas an sruth nō soír ó líne dhireach arna tarraingt ó Rinn Gibby go dtí an pointe is sia ó thuaidh de bhaile fearainn Phort na Sonn, agus
- (b) uisci taoide Abhann na hÉirne agus Abhann na Mainistreach seachas na coda diobh atá suas an sruth nō ó thuaidh de líne dhireach arna tarraingt ó theorainn bhaile Bhéal Átha Seanaigh mar a dteagmháontú sí le marc an lán mhabhar ar Rinn an Chnocáin Bháin go dtí an rinn talún dhá chéad agus seachtó slat ó thuaidh de Rinn Gibby.

BYE-LAW NO. 513.

NO. 13 OR BALLYSHANNON DISTRICT.

I, BRIAN Ó LUINEACHÁIN, Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Lands, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 9 of the Fisheries (Consolidation) Act, 1959 (No. 14 of 1959), and the Fisheries (Delegation of Ministerial Functions) Order, 1961 (S.I. No. 258 of 1961), hereby make the following Bye-law :—

1. This Bye-law may be cited as the Ballyshannon District Netting Bye-law No. 513, 1963.

2. (1) During the period commencing on the 2nd day of August, 1963, and ending on the 19th day of August, 1963, the prohibitions contained in the Ballyshannon District Bye-law No. 511, 1963, shall not apply in relation to the use in, or to the having in possession in any place on or near, the tidal waters to which this paragraph applies of draft nets of no greater length than eighty-five yards for the purpose of taking or with intent to take salmon or trout.

(2) This paragraph applies to—

- (a) the tidal waters of the River Erne other than the portion thereof which is situated upstream or to the eastward of a straight line drawn from Gibby Point to the northernmost point of the townland of Portnason, and
- (b) the tidal waters of the River Erne and Abbey River, other than the portions thereof which are situated upstream or to the northward of a straight line drawn from the town boundary of Ballyshannon where it meets high water mark at Whitehill Point to the point of land two hundred and seventy yards northward of Gibby Point.
