Appropriate Assessment (AA) screening to assess if the Offshore Renewable Energy

Development Plan II (OREDP II), individually or in combination with other plans or projects, is

likely to have a significant effect on a European Site(s).

In making the determination that AA is required, the information in the "OREDP II Appropriate

Assessment - Screening Report" prepared by NIRAS Group (UK) Ltd for ClearLead Consulting

Limited on behalf of the Department of Environment, Climate and Communications has been

considered. The Screening for AA found that:

The Plan is not directly connected to or necessary for the management of any

European Site.

• The Plan is likely to have a significant effect on Qualifying Interests (QIs) of multiple

European Sites.

On the basis of the findings in the Screening for AA, it concluded that an AA will be required on

the OREDP II to consider each Likely Significant Effect (LSE) identified in view of the conservation

objectives of the European Sites affected.

The Habitats Directive requires that plans or projects are assessed alone and in-combination

with other plans or projects to determine whether a likely significant effect to European sites

could occur. Only plans or projects that would increase the likelihood of significant effects

should be considered. As the implementation of the OREDP II has the potential to result in likely

significant effect on European sites, and should be taken forward to Stage 2: AA. In-combination

effects will be considered in the Natura Impact Statement.
