CONSERVATION OF SALMON AND SEA TROUT BYE-LAW NO. 830, 2007.

I, Eamon Ryan, Minister for Communications, Energy and Natural Resources, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 9 (as amended by section 3 of the Fisheries (Amendment) Act 1962 (No. 31 of 1962)) of the Fisheries (Consolidation) Act 1959 (No. 14 of 1959), section 33 of the Fisheries (Amendment) Act 1962, the Fisheries (Transfer of Departmental Administration and Ministerial Functions) Order 1977 (S.I. No. 30 of 1977) (as adapted by the Communications, Marine and Natural Resources (Alteration of Name of Department and Title of Minister) Order 2007 (S.I. No. 706 of 2007)) and having complied with the requirements of Regulation 31 of the European Communities (Natural Habitats) Regulations 1997 (S.I. No. 94 of 1997), hereby make the following bye-law:

1. (1) This Bye-law may be cited as the Conservation of Salmon and Sea Trout Bye-law No. 830, 2007.

(2) This Bye-law comes into operation on 1 January 2008.

2. In this Bye-law -

“salmon” means fish of the species *Salmo salar* (Atlantic salmon);

“sea trout” means fish of the migratory form of *Salmo trutta*, but does not include a sea trout which is 40 centimetres or less in length measured in a straight line from the tip of the snout to the fork of the tail.

3. It is prohibited for a person, in a river mentioned in column (2) of the Schedule opposite mention of a fishery district in column (1) of the Schedule, to -

(a) notwithstanding anything contained in the Conservation of Salmon and Sea Trout Bye-law No. 829, 2007, take by rod and line any salmon or sea trout from the waters of the river, unless the fish is handled carefully, not removed from and immediately returned alive to, those waters, or

(b) use or attempt to use any fish hooks, other than single barbless hooks, or worms as bait in angling for salmon or sea trout in the waters of the river.


