CLOSE SEASON.

EEL FISHERIES.

WE, the Inspectors of Irish Fisheries, in pursuance of the powers and authorities in us vested by the "Fisheries (Ireland) Act, 1869," and the Acts incorporated therewith, having taken the necessary preliminary steps for the purpose, do hereby decide that, in the District No. 152 heretofore defined and known as THE COLERAINE DISTRICT, situated within the Counties of Londonderry, Antrim, Tyrone, Down, Armagh, and Monaghan, the respective periods heretofore authorized or directed as the Close Time, during which it should not be lawful to hang or fix any Coghill, Eel, or other Net or Basket or Basketwork in the Eye, Gap, or Sluice of any Eel or other Weir, or to make use of any fixed Engine for taking Eels in or from any River within the said Coleraine District, shall cease.

And we do hereby further decide that the Close Time—during which it shall not be lawful to hang or fix any Coghill, Eel, or other Net or Basket or Basketwork in the Eye, Gap, or Sluice of any Eel or other Weir, or to make use of any fixed Engine for taking Eels in or from any River within the said Coleraine District—shall be between the 11th day of January and the 31st day of May in each year, both days inclusive.
