FISHERIES—IRELAND.

32 and 33 Vic., chap. 92, and the Acts incorporated therewith.

No. 8, or LIMERICK DISTRICT. CLOSE SEASON.

WE, the Inspectors of Irish Fisheries, acting in execution of the Fisheries (Ireland) Act, 1869, and the Acts incorporated therewith, in pursuance of the powers and authorities in us vested in that behalf by said Acts, do hereby decide that the respective periods authorized and directed, as the Close Time for Salmon and Trout in the District Number 8, heretofore defined and known as "The Limerick District," which "extends from Dunmore Head, in the County of Kerry, to Hag's Head, in the County of Clare, northward, and includes all that part of the Country, the Waters of which flow into the Coast between those points," situated in the Counties of Galway, Clare, Limerick, Kerry, Tipperary, Roscommon, King's, Mayo, Sligo, Meath, Queen's, Westmeath, Longford, Leitrim, Cork, and Cavan, shall cease.

1. And We do hereby further decide that the Close Time, during which no fish of the Salmon or Trout kind shall be killed, destroyed, or taken by any person or by any means whatsoever (save by Single Rods and Lines as hereinafter provided) in or from any Estuary, or on the Sea Coast, or in or from the Tideway of any River or Lake, or the part thereof where the tide ebbs and flows, or in or from any part of any River or Lake above the tideway or portion thereof where the tide ebbs and flows, in the said Limerick District (save and except in the Cashen River and its tributaries, and save also in that part of said District between Dunmore Head and Kerry Head, and in all Rivers running into the Sea between Dunmore Head and Kerry Head, within the said Limerick District, as hereinafter provided, and save also in that part of said District between Loop Head and Hag's Head, and in all Rivers running into the Sea between Loop Head and Hag's Head within the said Limerick District, as hereinafter provided), shall be between the 1st day of August in each Year and the 11th day of February in the Year following, both the said days inclusive.

2. And We do hereby further decide that the Close Time, during which no fish of the Salmon or Trout kind shall be killed, destroyed, or taken by any person by Single Rods and Lines in the said Limerick District (save in the Cashen and Maigue Rivers and their Tributaries, and save also in that part of said District between Dunmore Head and Kerry Head, and between Loop Head and Hag's Head, and in all Rivers running into the Sea between said points within the said Limerick District), shall be between the 1st day of October in each Year and the 31st day of January in the Year following, both the said days inclusive.

3. And We do hereby further decide that the Close Time, during which no fish of the Salmon or Trout kind shall be killed, destroyed, or taken by any person or by any means whatsoever (save by Single Rods and Lines as hereinafter provided) in or from any part of the Cashen River down to its Mouth, and its Tributaries, shall be between the 1st day of September in each Year and the 31st day of May in the Year following, both the said days inclusive.

4. And We do hereby further decide that the Close Time, during which no fish of the Salmon or Trout kind shall be killed, destroyed, or taken by any person by Single Rods and Lines in the Cashen River and its Tributaries, shall be between the 1st day of October in each Year and the 15th day of March in the Year following, both the said days inclusive.

5. And We do hereby further decide that the Close Time, during which no fish of the Salmon or Trout kind shall be killed, destroyed, or taken by any person or by any means whatsoever, between Dunmore Head and Kerry Head, or in or from any Estuary, or in or from the Tideway of any River or Lake, or the part thereof where the tide ebbs and flows, or in or from any part of any River or Lake above the tideway, or portion thereof where the tide ebbs and flows, in that part of said Limerick District between Dunmore Head and Kerry Head, shall be between the 16th day of September in each Year and the 31st day of March in the Year following, both the said days inclusive.

6. And We do hereby further decide that the Close Time, during which no fish of the Salmon or Trout kind shall be killed, destroyed, or taken by any person or by any means whatsoever, in that part of said District between Loop Head and Hag's Head, or in or from any Estuary, or in or from the Tideway of any River or Lake, or the part thereof where the tide ebbs and flows, or in or from any part of any River or Lake above the tideway or portion thereof where the tide ebbs and flows, in that part of said Limerick District between Loop Head and Hag's Head, shall be between the 16th September in each Year and the 30th April in the Year following, both the said days inclusive.

7. And We do hereby further decide that the Close Time, during which no fish of the Salmon or Trout kind shall be killed, destroyed, or taken by Single Rods and Lines in or from any part of the Maigue River and its Tributaries, shall be between the 1st day of October in each Year and the 19th day of February in the Year following, both said days inclusive.
