CLOSE SEASON.

WE, the Inspectors of Irish Fisheries, acting in execution of the Fisheries (Ireland) Act, 1869, and the Acts incorporated therewith, in pursuance of the powers and authorities in us vested in that behalf by said Acts, or some or one of them, do hereby decide that the respective periods authorized and directed as the Close Time for Salmon and Trout in the District No. 3, heretofore defined and known as "The Waterford District," situated in the Counties of Waterford, Kilkenny, Carlow, Tipperary, Wexford, Queen's, King's, and Kildare, shall cease.

1. And We do hereby further decide that the Close Time during which it shall not be lawful to kill, destroy, or take Salmon or Trout within the said Waterford District, with Nets and all other Engines (save single Rods and Lines only), shall be between the 16th day of August in each Year and the 31st day of January in the Year following, both said days inclusive.

And We do hereby further decide that the Close Time during which it shall not be lawful to kill, destroy, or take Salmon or Trout in the said Waterford District, with single Rods and Lines only, shall be between the 1st day of October in each Year and the 31st day of January in the Year following, both days inclusive.
