CLOSE SEASON.

WE, the Inspectors of Irish Fisheries, acting in execution of the Fisheries (Ireland) Act, 1869, and the Acts incorporated therewith, in pursuance of the powers and authorities in us vested in that behalf by said Acts, do hereby decide that the respective periods authorized and directed as the Close time for Salmon and Trout in that part of the District No. 13, heretofore defined and known as "The Ballyshannon District," which embraces the Estuary of the River Eske as defined, and the said River Eske and its Tributaries situated in the County of Donegal shall cease.

1. And We do hereby further decide that the Close Time, during which no Fish of the Salmon or Trout kind shall be killed, destroyed, or taken by any Person, or by any means whatsoever (save by Single Rods and Lines as hereinafter provided), in or from the Estuary of the River Eske as defined, or in or from the said River Eske and its Tributaries situated in the County of Donegal, shall be between the 18th September in each year and the 31st March in the Year following, both the said days inclusive.

2. And We do hereby further decide that the Close Time, during which no Fish of the Salmon or Trout kind shall be killed, destroyed, or taken by any Person, or by Single Rods and Lines, in the said River Eske and all Tributaries falling into said River, shall be between the 10th day of October in each Year and the last day of February in the Year following, both the said days inclusive.
