# FISHERIES—IRELAND.

## No. 5, or CORK DISTRICT.

### CLOSE SEASON.

WE, the Inspectors of Irish Fisheries, acting in execution of the Fisheries (Ireland) Act, 1869, and the Acts incorporated therewith, in pursuance of the powers and authorities in Us vested in that behalf by said Acts, do hereby decide that the respective periods authorized and directed as the Close Time for Salmon and Trout in the District No. 5, heretofore defined and known as "The Cork District," which "extends from Ballycotton Head, westward, to Galley Head, both in the County of Cork, and includes all that part of the Country the Waters of which flow into the Coast between those points," situated in the County of Cork, shall cease.

1. And We do hereby further decide that the Close Time, during which no Fish of the Salmon or Trout kind shall be killed, destroyed, or taken by any Person, or by any means whatsoever (save by single Rods and Lines as hereinafter provided), in or from any Estuary, or on the Sea Coast, or in or from the Tideway of any River or Lake, or the part thereof where the tide ebbs and flows, or in or from any part of any River or Lake above the Tideway or portion thereof where the tide ebbs and flows, in the said Cork District (save and except in the Bandon and Arrigadeen Rivers, and the Estuary and Tideways thereof, and their Tributaries), shall be between the 16th day of August in each year and the 14th day of February in the Year following, both the said days inclusive.

2. And We do hereby further decide that the Close Time, during which no Fish of the Salmon or Trout kind shall be killed, destroyed, or taken by any Person or by any means whatsoever (save by single Rods and Lines as hereinafter provided) in or from any part of the Bandon River, the Estuary or Tideway thereof, and its Tributaries, shall be between the 16th day of August in each Year and the last day of February in the Year following, both the said days inclusive.

3. We do hereby further decide that the Close Time, during which no Fish of the Salmon or Trout kind shall be killed, destroyed, or taken by any person or by any means whatsoever (save by single Rods and Lines as hereinafter provided) in or from any part of the Arrigadeen River, the Estuary or Tideway thereof, and its Tributaries, shall be between the 1st day of September in each Year and the last day of February in the Year following, both the said days inclusive.

4. We do hereby further decide that the Close Time during which no Fish of the Salmon or Trout kind shall be killed, destroyed, or taken by any person by single Rods and Lines in the said Cork District, shall be between the 1st day of September in each Year and the 14th day of February in the Year following, both the said days inclusive.
