## CLOSE SEASON.

WE, the Inspectors of Irish Fisheries, acting in execution of the Fisheries (Ireland) Act, 1869, and the Acts incorporated therewith, in pursuance of the powers and authorities in Us vested in that behalf by said Acts, do hereby decide that the respective periods authorized and directed as the Close Time for Salmon and Trout in the District No. 4, heretofore defined and known as "The Lismore District," which "extends from Helvick Head in the County of Waterford, westward, to Ballycotton, in the County of Cork, and includes all that part of the Country the Waters of which flow into the Coast between those Points," shall cease.

- 1. And We do hereby further decide that the Close Time, during which it shall not be lawful to kill, destroy, or take Salmon or Trout within the said Lismore District, with Nets and all other Engines (save single Rods and Lines only,) shall be between the 1st day of September in each Year and the 15th day of February in the Year following, both said days inclusive.
- 2. And We do hereby further decide that the Close Time during which it shall not be lawful to kill, destroy, or take Salmon or Trout in the said Lismore District, with single Rods and Lines only, shall be between the 13th October in each Year and the 14th February in the Year following, both said days inclusive.
