RIVER BROWN FLESK AND TRIBUTARIES.

CLOSE SEASON, SINGLE RODS AND LINES.

WE, The Inspectors of Irish Fisheries, acting in execution of the Fisheries (Ireland) Act, 1869, and the Acts incorporated therewith, in pursuance of the powers and authorities in us vested in that behalf by said Acts, do hereby decide that the period authorized and directed as the Close Time during which it shall not be lawful to capture Salmon and Trout, by means of Single Rods and Lines only, in the River Brown Flesk and its Tributaries, or in any of the other Tributaries of the Maine or Castlemaine River, in "The Killarney District," shall cease.

1. And We do hereby further decide that the Close Time, during which it shall not be lawful to kill, destroy, or take Salmon or Trout in the River Brown Flesk and its Tributaries, or in any of the other Tributaries of the Maine or Castlemaine River, in the said Killarney District, with Single Rods and Lines only, shall be between the 1st October in each Year and 10th April in the Year following, both said days inclusive.
