Conditionality is a set of baseline requirements under the new CAP Strategic Plan

Beneficiaries of the Basic Income Support Scheme and other CAP Payments must adhere to these requirements

Protection of Environmentally Sensitive Permanent Grassland in Natura 2000 sites



Area Monitoring System (AMS)





Information from sentinel satellites will determine agricultural activity in a land parcel



AMS will monitor land-based CAP Schemes

In 2023, this will include BISS, ANC, Protein Aid & SIM

Benefits: less inspections, warning alerts, facility to make changes

Compliance is indicated using a traffic light system
