TRADER NOTICE

To all operators responsible for consignments (RFCs) with responsibility for consignment requiring official controls at a BCP on entry into Ireland:

TN 06/2022: Requirement to attach a complete copy of the Health Certificate, Chapter 20 declaration or private attestation to all CHED-P documents

To provide traceability for a consignment at the place of destination in addition to the CHED a copy of the official certificate, document (e.g., Chapter 20 declaration) or private attestation must be available. To achieve this requirement for electronic copies of the CHED when completing Part I of the CHED-P or CHED-A, it is necessary for the RFC to upload and attach a scanned version of the entire official certificate (preferably in colour) or other official document to the CHED on TRACES in all cases.

If possible, please upload the pages of the certificate as separate files to the CHED-P. If this is proving unwieldy, please upload the certificate in black and white

This will ensure that an electronic copy of the document in question is available to the RFC via TRACES after official controls have been completed, without the need for paper copies of these documents, and ensures compliance with Article 50 (1) and (2) of the Official Controls Regulation.

RFCs are requested to ensure that the uploading of these documents is done for all future consignments.
