Information specific to the personal data being collected:

The following data is specific information in relation to the personal data processed in respect of applications for a:
Car Park Permit in Ros an Mhíl Fishery Harbour Centre.

1. Specified purpose

Registration data is used:

- To allocate a Car Park Permit to a specific applicant and car
- To manage the use of Car Park Permits
- and to provide for other related matters.

2. The legal basis:

The legal basis for collecting and processing your data is set out in the following primary and secondary legislation and in addition, statutory instruments may be enacted under this primary legislation:

- Fishery Harbour Centres Act, 1968
- S.I. No. 214 of 2012: Fishery Harbour Centres (Rates and Charges) Order 2012
- Fishery Harbour Centre (Management, Control, Operation & Development) Bye Laws, 1979

3. Recipients:

In this instance, the data gathered will be used by the Department, including members of staff in the harbour, for the purposes of administering this scheme only.

4. Transferred outside the EU:

This does not apply in this instance as no data will be transferred outside the EU.



5. Retention Period:

An applicant who wishes to request that their personal data deleted may do so by making a request to cancel their Car Park Permit in writing to the Department by emailing:

fhcpropertyunit@agriculture.gov.ie

The data collected in respect of the application for a Car Park Permit in Ros an Mhíl Fishery Harbour Centre will be held by the Department for 2 years after the expiry of the permit. After this time, it will be marked for destruction and will be destroyed in line with internal guidelines or guidelines for destruction received from the National Archives Office or associated permissions received from them.

6. Data provision being statutory or contractual obligation:

The data provided to apply for a Car Park Permit in Ros an Mhíl Fishery Harbour Centre is:

- provided on a contractual basis
- required only if the customer wished to apply for the Car Permit. There is no legal obligation to provide this information.
- Failure to provide the necessary information will make the applicant ineligible for a Car Park Permit.

7. Automated Decision Making:

This does not apply in this instance as no automated decision making will take place.

8. Information from Third Party:

This does not apply in this instance as information is gather for the applicant only.
