# **Advance notifications**

Advance notifications are a mandatory requirement for Importers and First Consignees in relation to third country imports. The operator responsible for a consignment shall give prior notification **at least one working day** before the expected arrival of the consignment, as set out in Article 1 of Commission Implementing Regulation 2019/1013.

Control requirements for import of plants, plant products, livestock products and foodstuffs comprising of plant and/or livestock products, animal feeding stuffs, compound feeding stuffs and feed materials from third countries are set out in Chapter 5 of Title IV of the Commission Regulation 889/2008. In accordance with Article 84 of the aforementioned regulation, the importer shall in due time, inform the control body or control authority of each consignment to be imported to the European Community. A person who contravenes Chapter 5 of Title IV of the Commission Regulation 889/2008 commits an offence under Regulation 47 of Statutory Instrument 683 of 2016 as per circular 01 of 2021

The Registered Imports Portal is a simple and fast way to login to Agfood.ie and notify the Department in advance of planned Organic imports subject to checks and inspections.

The portal can also be used to view submitted declarations and upload additional information/documents that might be required.




# Add MRN and COI number and upload required documents

MRN is issued to the agent when a declaration using the AIS system is completed and uploaded to Revenue's system. Organic products should be declared by using the code C644 (The MRN will remain at the registered status until arrival in Ireland. Then it will come under Customs control and can be processed.) 
