

## PROFESSIONAL VISITS BY FRENCH TEACHERS INVITATION FOR EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST FROM INTERESTED SCHOOLS 2023/2024

The Department of Education and the French Education Ministry have agreed a programme to place 18 French teachers in Irish post-primary schools for a period of two weeks. A similar scheme is available for Irish teachers of French to spend two weeks in a French school.

The scheme aims to promote teacher mobility; to encourage the European dimension in education; to strengthen links and relationships between schools and teachers in Ireland and France; to promote languages and teachers' professional development; to encourage professional dialogue and the sharing of good practice; and to facilitate the setting up of exchange projects between teachers and students. The visiting teacher may be a teacher of English or may be a teacher of another subject such as History, Science, Economics etc.

Some key aspects of the scheme are set out below:

- The visiting teacher will expect to be welcomed into the school and to be allowed participate in all areas of school life. The French authorities suggest that the teacher should accompany the French language teachers into some classes and that they should also have the opportunity to visit classes in their own subject (English) and in other subjects of interest to them.
- The school needs to be prepared to help the teacher to find accommodation and to assist with meals e.g. lunch. Assistance with travel to the school may also be required if there is some distance between the school and the visitor's accommodation.
- The approval of the principal who will be responsible for ensuring that the teacher is made welcome in the school.
- The designation of a liaison teacher within the school to take charge of the necessary arrangements.
