Schedule of Updates for Eurostat Statistics 2023



This calendar records the planned submission dates for the Department of Justice contribution to Eurostat immigration statistics in 2023. Statistics are categorised by publication frequency: monthly, quarterly or annual.

In each following month, the timeliness of releases in the previous month will be shown by colour code.
