To: All registered professional operators

Subject: Annual Update of Professional Operator Information

In accordance with Article 66(5) of Plant Health Regulation (EU) 2016/2031, Professional operators **must notify** this Department of any change to the details of their registration on the Official Register of Professional Operators.

There are two updates required:

- 1. Any change to the name, address and contact details of a professional operator must be notified within 30 days of the change occurring.
- 2. Any other amendments including but not limited to commodity types, species of plants must be updated **annually** to the Department

This Trader Notice is informing you of the deadline to provide the annual update as per point 2 above – **Friday 10th March 2023**

It is a legislative requirement that this update is submitted annually to the Department, regardless of whether your information has changed or not.
