TB Programme Funding	The Department presented an updated PowerPoint presentation on proposals to the TB Programme Funding. The presentation outlined a number of increases to the current rates of Income Supplement, Depopulation Grant and Hardship Grant.

Some concern shown regarding one reactor and using a book value instead of a live valuation. A speedy removal of animals is a must.
