
National 7 Day Incidence























Clusters



In week 37 (6th September-12th September) 2020 there were **158** COVID-19 outbreaks notified to HPSC, **140** of which were in the last week.

- 73 outbreaks in private houses and 6 outbreaks in extended families (including a family funeral, a general outbreak involving a holiday village)
- 4 outbreaks occurred in nursing homes


There were 22 new COVID-19 workplace outbreaks notified during week 37 including:

- 1 meat processing plant
- 1 fish shop/restaurant with a food production facility for distribution
- 1 fitness gym
- 2 construction companies/sites
- 1 warehouse
- 1 grocery retailer











- Americas continue to have the highest incidence rates globally.









Number and Proportion of Cases in Dublin


